GIANT RED CRAYFISH

(Mini Lobster)

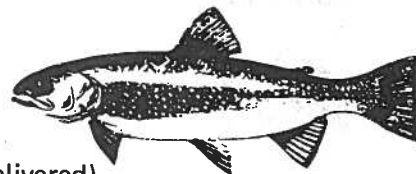
The Red Crayfish feeds mainly on aquatic vegetation, algae, dead fish, crayfish, or shell fish. They are excellent eating, comparable to lobster in flavor. The Red Crayfish can grow to quite a large size; up to 8 inches in length.

Crayfish can be caught in traps similar to minnow traps and on lines baited with chicken necks or backs, or a small dead fish at the end of the line. The Crayfish should be retrieved slowly. The Crayfish will hold on to the bait and can be dipped up with a hand dip net.

— ORNAMENTAL — SHALLOW WATER FLOWERING PLANTS

Plants and Lilies are a must in a pond as they perform the job of attracting natural food, insects, etc. They also provide shelter for smaller fish by providing a crop of fish every year to grow into adult fish. Without plants your pond will soon end up to be a sterile looking water hole, with a few large hungry fish. Plants also help in the control of bank erosion.

We strongly suggest planting shallow areas with flowering plants and lilies to provide a natural habitat for your smaller fish.

KNOB RUSH:

Quill type plant used for pond bank erosion control.

BULL RUSH:

Quill type plant used for erosion control.

WATER CRESS:

Used in food salads. Makes excellent fish cover.

ARROW HEAD:

Thin arrow shaped leaves which produces white flower.

DUCK POTATO:

Thick arrow shaped leaves produces white flowers and potato roots.

PARROT FEATHER:

Thin velvety green leaves roots on the bottom near shore growing out of water.

WATER IRIS:

Beautiful flowering plants grow at water edge. Colors assorted blue and yellow.

SWEET FLAG:

Light green tall plant with beautiful flowers.

CATTAIL:

Beautiful tall thin green plant.

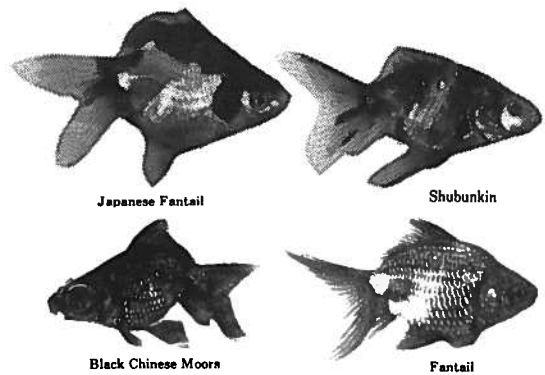
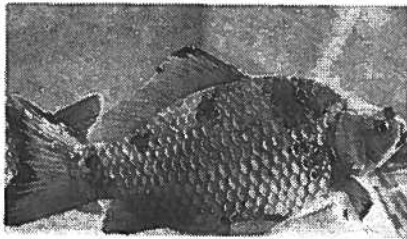

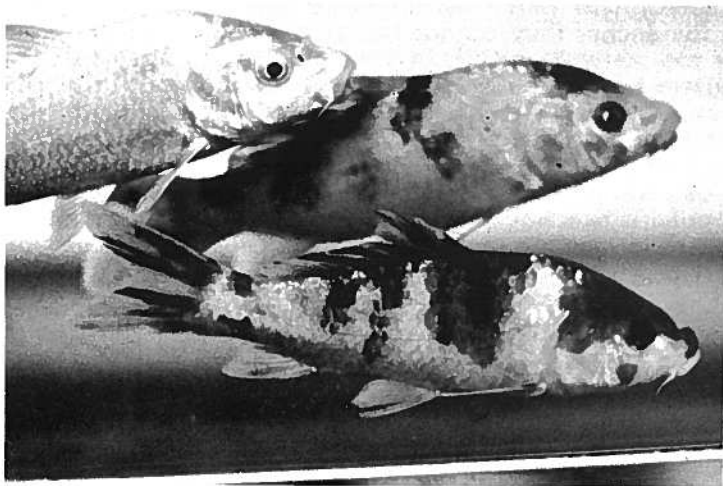

Japanese Ornamental Algae Eater

The KOI is an ornamental fish for your pond. They are brilliantly colored with solid or patchy flashy colors. The mixture of colors includes white, red, yellow, orange, black, silver, blue, and all the colors of the rainbow. They are excellent for algae control as they feed mainly on algae and weeds. They can grow to over 2 feet in length, but usually average around the 20 inch mark in most lakes or ponds.

The stocking rate for algae control is 24 per surface acre depending on the amount of algae. If you have more algae, stock a few more, or if the algae problem isn't bad you can stock less.

KOI will not overpopulate a pond where there is a Bass population. Because of their bright colors, their young make excellent feed for the Bass. KOI are a beautiful fish and can be seen most all the time in your pond because of their brilliant vibrant colors.

They are not a territorial fish, and they live peacefully with each other and other fish. They also can be fed fish feed and will become real pets. They can be trained to feed out of your hands. Japanese Emperors have prized the KOI for centuries for their garden ponds. Why not try a few of these amusing and useful fish.

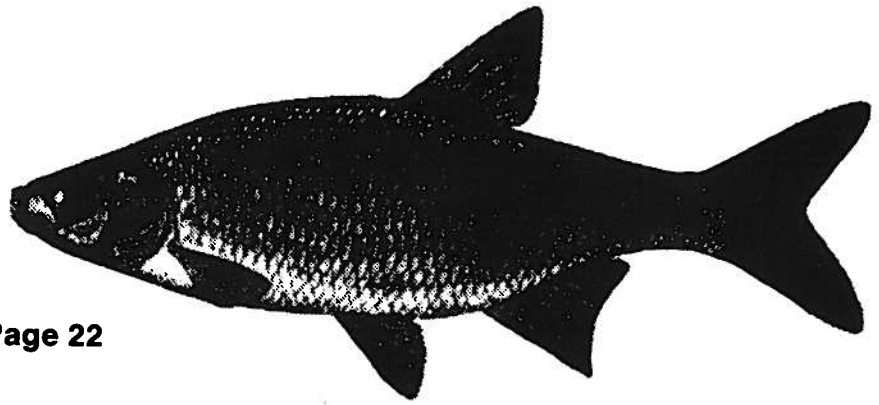

SILVER SHINERS

Shiners are very prolific spawners. They produce thousands of young forage fish for your Bass. Bass grow much larger in ponds stocked with shiners. They seldom, if ever, get overpopulated because of their brilliant silvery or gold shiney color and being surface fish they become easy prey for bass.

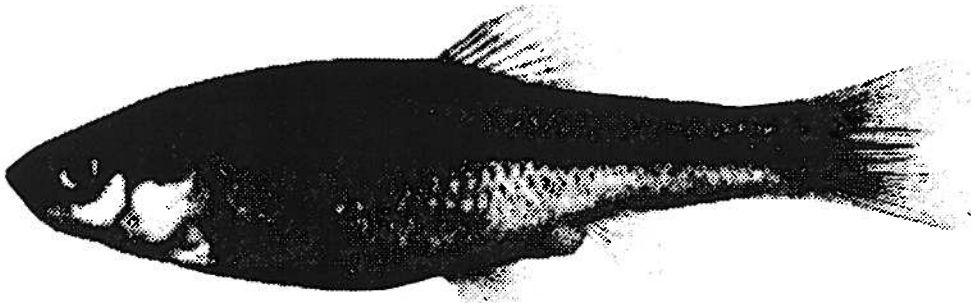
Shiners spawn on grass and debri in your pond. If you have a new pond, scatter a few bales of hay for them to spawn on. When the hay decomposes after the spawn it will enrich your water for daphnia and plankton to grow on.

Shiners turn a very beautiful gold color when they are ready to spawn. They spawn in mid summer. They hatch in 6 to 8 days depending on water temperature.

The Silver Shiner can grow up to 12 inches in length, but normally average 6" to 8" in ponds.

Shiners can also be grown commercially for Bass and Pike bait. There is always a good market for large Shiners for bait, especially if you live near fishing areas.

We suggest you stock 1,000 breeders per surface acre. Several hundred thousand bait size Shiners can be produced per acre pond.

FATHEAD MINNOWS

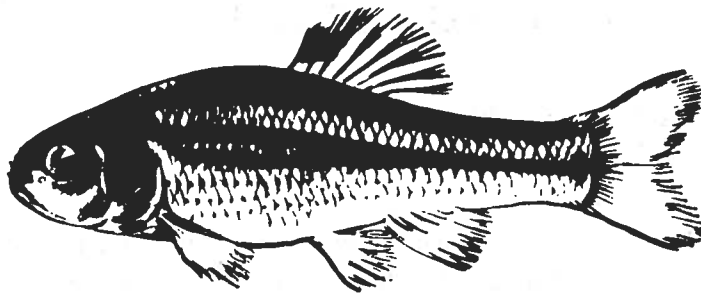
The Fathead Minnow is a small minnow usually growing no more than three inches in length. They spawn many times throughout the summer, attaching their eggs on stones, weeds, or debri in your pond.

They produce feed for your fish when it is needed the most; in the fingerling stage of life. When stocking a new pond with all fingerling fish, by all means stock the Fathead Minnow. Your fish will grow much better, and you will have much greater success with your stocking. Stock 500 or 1,000 minnows in your pond for the extra feed fingerling fish will need to get started.

The Fathead Minnow is a top and bottom feeder, usually feeding on algae, insects, and snails. They usually mature in one season. Fathead Minnows can also be produced for bait commercially. For this, you need to stock 5,000 breeders per surface acre in a clean pond. Then, buy 100 lb. to 200 lb. of wheat middling or meat scrap to feed them. Feed them sparingly. They retail for \$1.50 to \$2.00 per dozen. There is always a market for live minnows for bait. Hundreds of thousands can be raised per acre. This can be an enterprising business for young children, the retired, or any hobbyist, and can grow into quite a business. For a several hundred dollar investment you can earn up to \$10,000 per acre. Why not give it a try ???

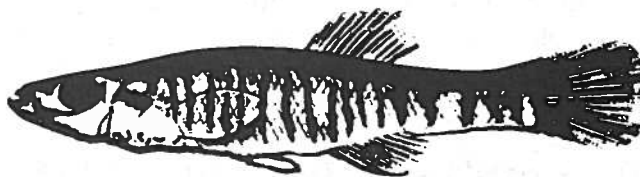

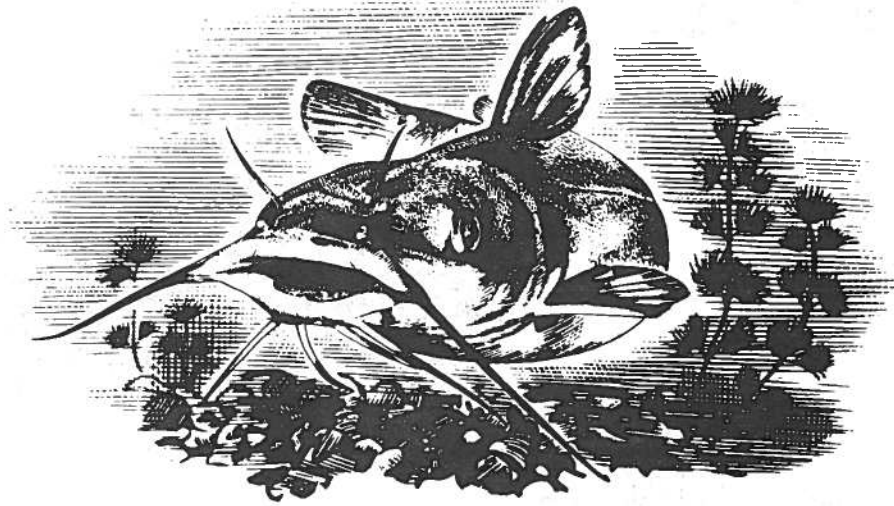

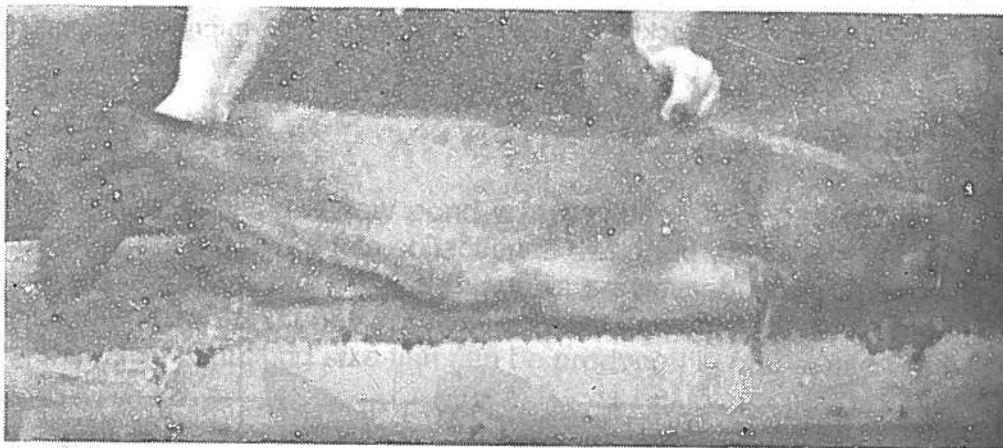
GREAT MISSISSIPPI "BLUE" CHANNEL CATFISH

The Blue Cats can grow quite large, to over a hundred pounds or more. They normally average 15 to 20 pounds in most ponds or lakes.

The Mississippi Blue Catfish is truly a monster of the deep, seeking the deepest part of your pond or lake. They will take most any type of live bait.

The Blue Cat will bite from early spring until late fall, they also will bite in the winter months, but have very little fight in them. Of course, when hooked on the end of a line in the summertime you are in for a fight. Blue Catfish make excellent fish for Fee Fishing Ponds and Game and Sportsmen Clubs. They are also good for private ponds.

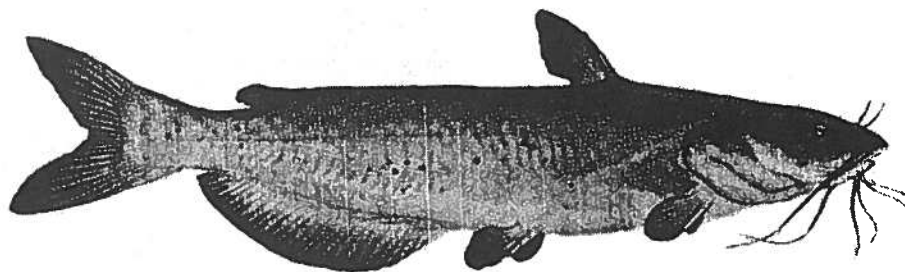

White Catfish can grow up to 30 inches in length, averaging 25 inches to 30 inches in length in ponds. They are the fastest growing catfish.

White Cats are a game fish striking lures, plugs, and live bait.

White Catfish spawn readily in ponds. A few or half dozen spawning containers should be placed in shallow water 2 or 3 feet deep. The best containers are old milk cans, or full liners 12 inches square with one end sealed off. Lay them flat on the bottom. The White Catfish spawn in the summer months.

The Channel Catfish is the finest member of the catfish family. The meat of the Channel Catfish is pure white with an excellent flavor and has few bones.

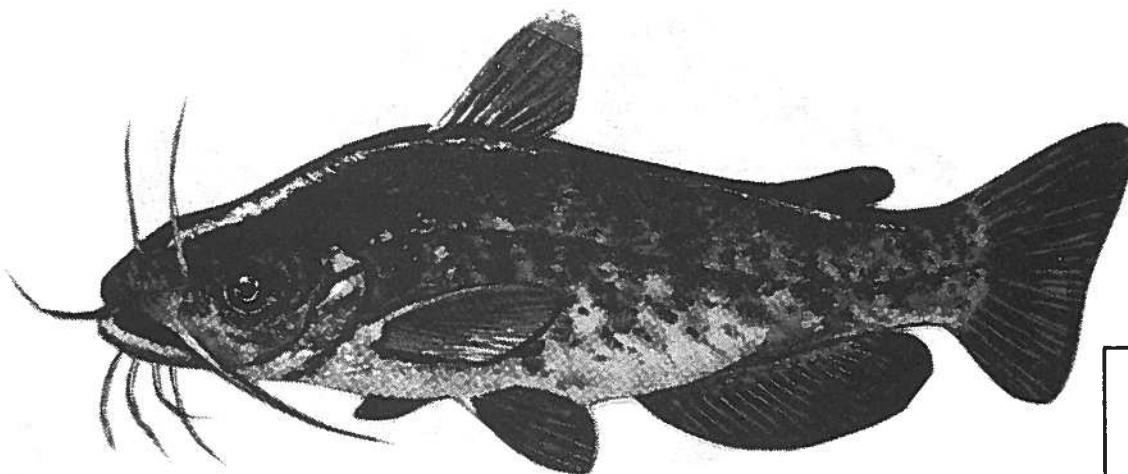
They strike artificial lures and baits and also can be caught on live bait. They are truly a sporting gamefish.

The Channel Catfish can grow to over 100 lbs. in weight, but most commonly grow to 10 lbs. to 15 lbs. in average ponds. They spawn in the summer. Naturally, spawning they use holes or caves in the banks to deposit their eggs and they fan them with their tail until they hatch.

In most ponds for the spawn and hatch to be successful, you must place several spawning containers for your Channel Catfish to spawn in. Five gallon milk cans or flue liners (closed off on one end) are excellent for this.

Catfish feed mainly on snails, clams, algae, and weeds. They are mainly bottom feeders. Be sure to stock Channel Cats when stocking your pond as they are excellent for algae control and general pond bottom cleaning. Channel Catfish are an excellent fish for Fee Fishing Lakes and they are king when it comes to raising fish for the commercial market. 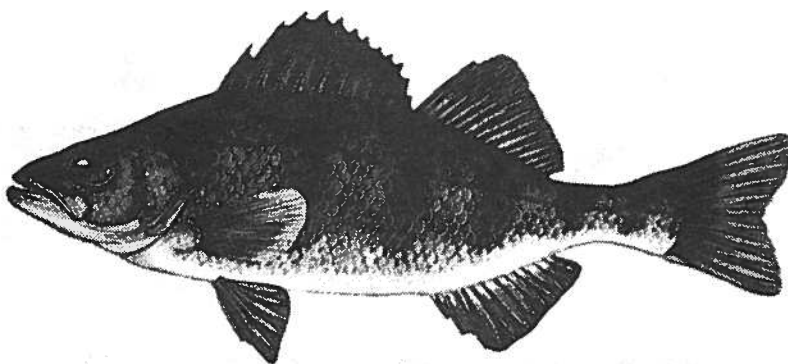

BROWN AND YELLOW BULLHEAD CATFISH

Bullhead catfish are an excellent eating fish. Their pink meat is comparable to that of the salmon. They spawn readily in ponds. Bullheads spawn in the early summer. The young usually stay in large schools until reaching 1 inch to 2 inches. Then they scatter out. They seldom overpopulate ponds with bass stocked in them. All ponds should be stocked with bullhead, as they are excellent bass feed.

The Bullhead can grow up to 14 inches in length, usually averaging 12 inches in ponds. They feed on snails, clams, algae, weeds, etc. They are bottom feeders; keeping the bottom clean. They will bite on most any kind of live bait.

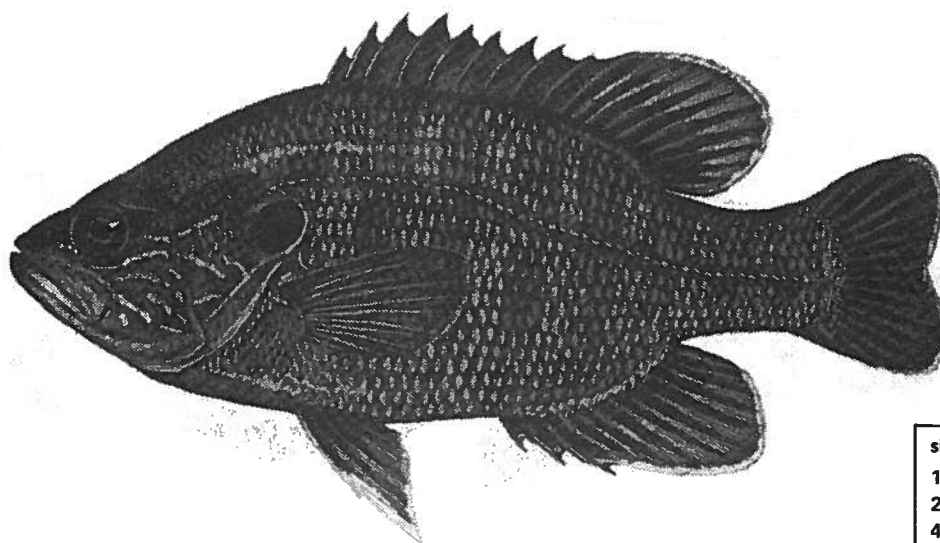
SEMINOLE STRIPED YELLOW PERCH

(European Strain)

Striped Yellow Perch are truly the largest of the perch family. They are considered by many people to be a miniature Walleye. Their eating qualities are excellent. Perch adapt to a wide variety of water conditions and climatic conditions. These giant Yellow Perch readily spawn in ponds, spawning early in the spring. They string their eggs out in ribbon like strings close to the shore. Eggs hatch in four days to a week depending on water temperature. A pond or lake is seldom if ever over populated with Blue Gills when the Seminole Perch is stocked. These Perch are not the small Perch found in the Great Lakes area. The Seminole Perch can attain a size up to 16" in length, averaging 12" to 14" in length in most ponds. They are an excellent fish to stock for fishing lakes, or private ponds, or fishing clubs.

Yellow Perch possess excellent angling qualities as they bite year round regardless of weather conditions or temperature. They make excellent fish for ice fishing.

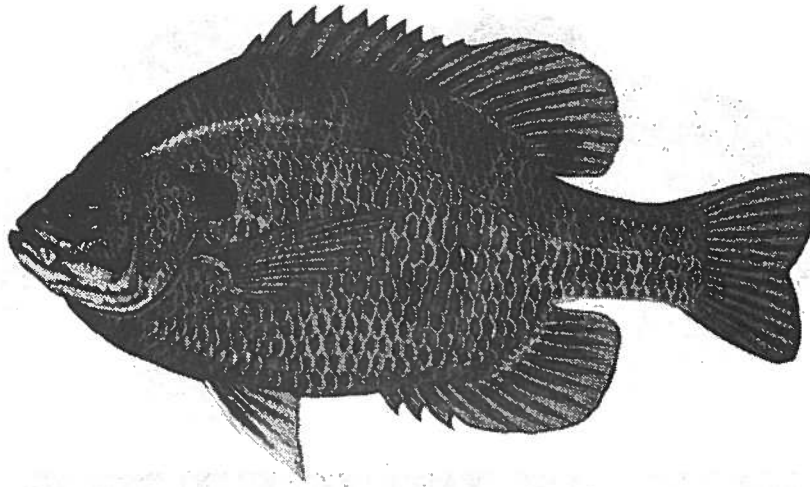
GREEN SUNFISH

The Green Sunfish is a member of the bream family. They are an excellent eating fish, and make a great fish for the angler. They will strike on lures, plugs, spinners, spoons, and live bait. Sunfish do well with Blue and Red Gills, and some will cross breed making a hybrid fish.

Sunfish are a fast growing fish and can attain a size of up to 10 inches. They spawn in early summer by beating the nests out with their tails and depositing eggs, which hatch in approximately a week. They have a beautiful green color with a black dot on their gills and yellow fringes around their fins.

GIANT JUMBO BLUE GILLS AND RED GILLS

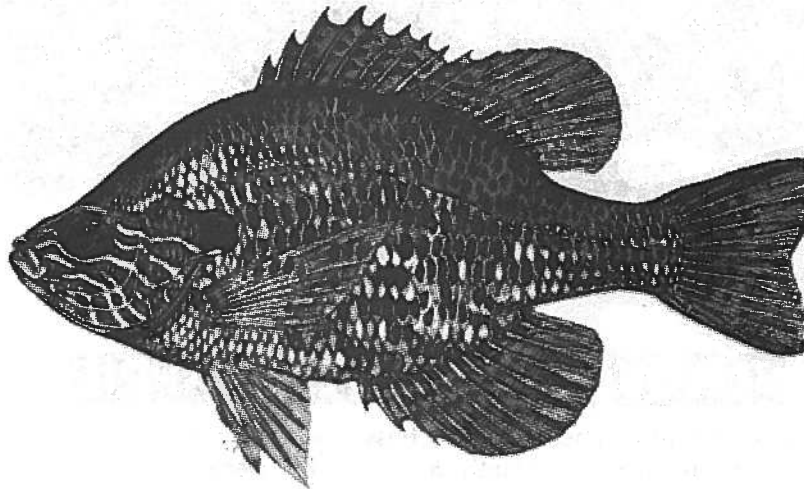
The Blue Gills are an excellent fish for children's fishing and they are an excellent eating fish. Our Jumbo Blue Gill can attain a size of up to 12 inches in length, averaging 9 inches to 10 inches.

Under our breeding programs we breed only the largest, thick bodied Blue Gills and have greatly improved the common strain of Blue Gill. Our Jumbo Blue Gill can be stocked with an existing Blue Gill population to upgrade their size, and by all means when you are starting a new pond, stock our Jumbo strain of Blue Gill.

When stocking Bass, always stock Blue Gills as they spawn throughout the summer providing many small fish for your bass to feed on. Bass cannot be raised successfully with minnows or shiners alone. The bass will chase them down and eat them down to the last one.

Blue Gill have a wider body and spines on top and after they get 5 inches or better the bass usually can't eat them so this provides you with breeder fish.

There are times when ponds will get too many Blue Gills in them. If this is the case, add a few more bass, yellow perch, or an aggressive predator such as the Walleye, Pickerel, or Pike.



HYBRID BLUE GILLS

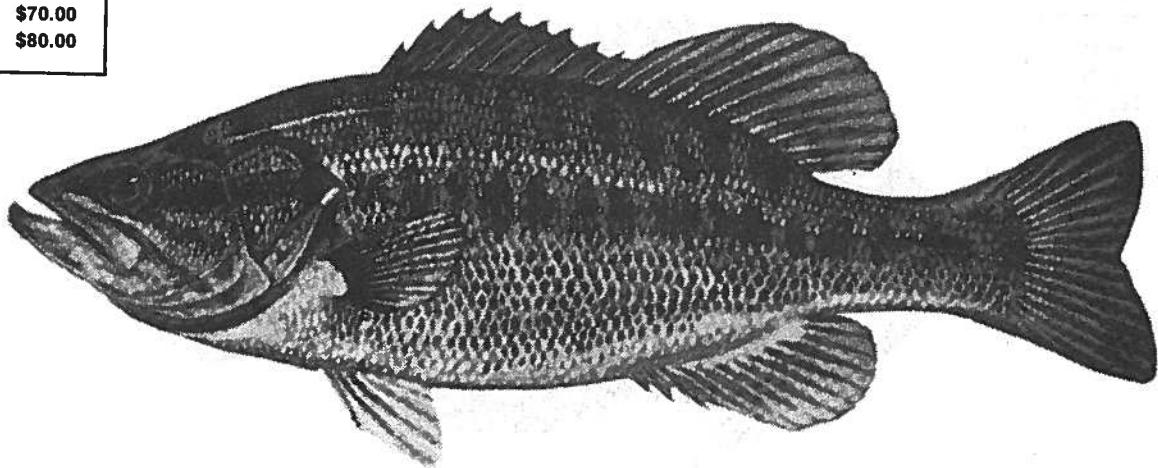
We have discontinued Hybrid Blue Gills as they spawn very little if any. Their offspring turn into a very small trashy fish which grow only a few inches in length. The size of the hybrid is over exaggerated. A pure strain Giant Blue Gill will grow larger or just as large.

They are a very predatory voracious fish which will destroy your bass population in your pond. At one time the Hybrid Blue Gill was highly recommended by Soil Conservations, but after research work, they no longer recommend them.

We recommend our Giant Blue Gills as they will produce plenty of feed for your Bass and grow into a nice size Blue Gill.

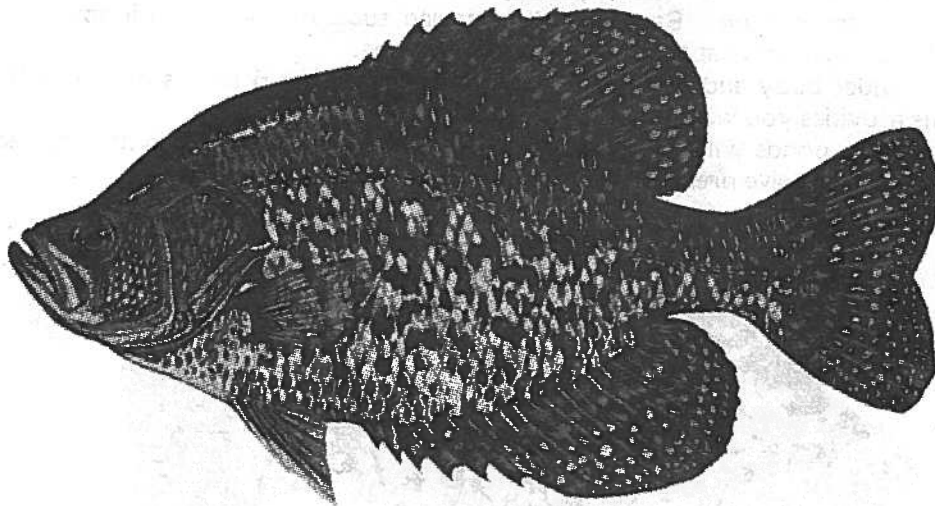


SPOTTED SMALL MOUTH BASS

It is sometimes called the Kentucky bass. It is an in between species of bass. It is much like the Large Mouth and the Small Mouth Bass. It can grow up to five pounds, normally averaging two or three pounds in ponds. The Spotted Bass is a very fast growing Bass, usually maturing in two years. They feed mainly on live feed, fish, crayfish, etc.

They spawn in the summer months, similarly to the Large Mouth Bass. They sculpture a nest on the bottom with their tail and deposit the eggs.

They are very similar in appearance to the Large Mouth, except the Spotted Bass has diamond markings and doesn't grow quite as large.

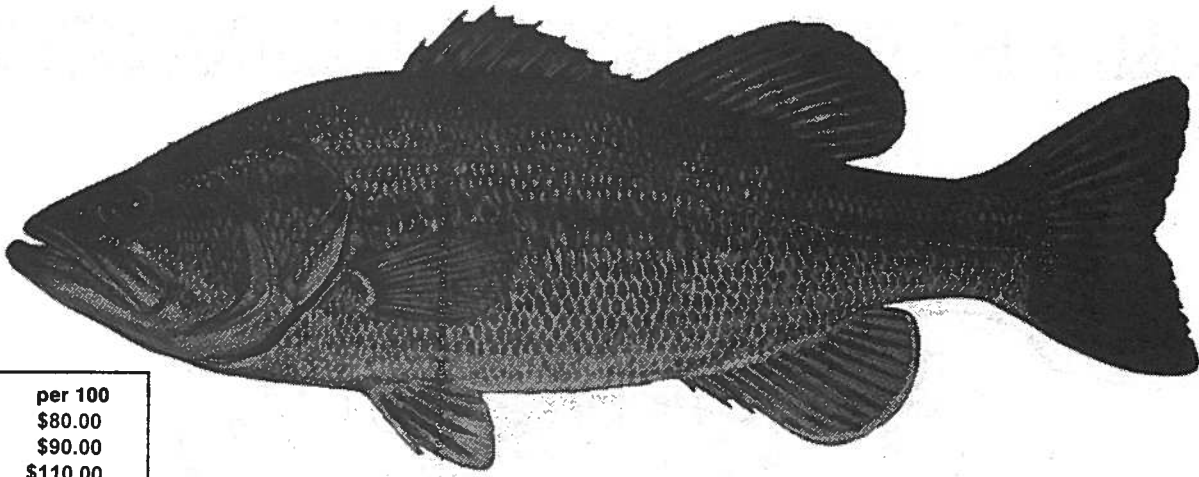

The Crappie has many common names: Crappie Bass, Specs, Calico, etc. It is the largest of the bream family. They can grow up to 18 inches in length but normally average 12 inches to 14 inches in ponds. The Crappie is both a forage fish and predator. This unique characteristic helps control their numbers and that of the Blue Gill.

Crappie should be stocked in all ponds with Blue Gills as they are excellent eating and are a fine sporting fish striking lures, plugs, live bait, etc. Crappie usually congregate around pier areas or areas with brush or debris. They spawn in early summer producing many fish for forage for themselves, the bass, and some grow to maturity.

The Crappies principal feed is minnows, snails, and insects. There are two types of crappie: the Black Crappie and White Crappie. The Black Crappie has 7 to 8 spines on the back; the White Crappie has 6 to 7 spines on the back.

We keep both species mixed together so you usually get some of both.

LARGE MOUTH BASS

One of the most commonly stocked Bass for ponds and lakes is the Large Mouth Bass. Large Mouth Bass can attain a size up to 10 lbs. in weight, and average 7 lbs. to 8 lbs. at maturity with proper forage fish. Our breeding program has produced a super strain of Bass with a heavy body, vibrant coloration, and markings.

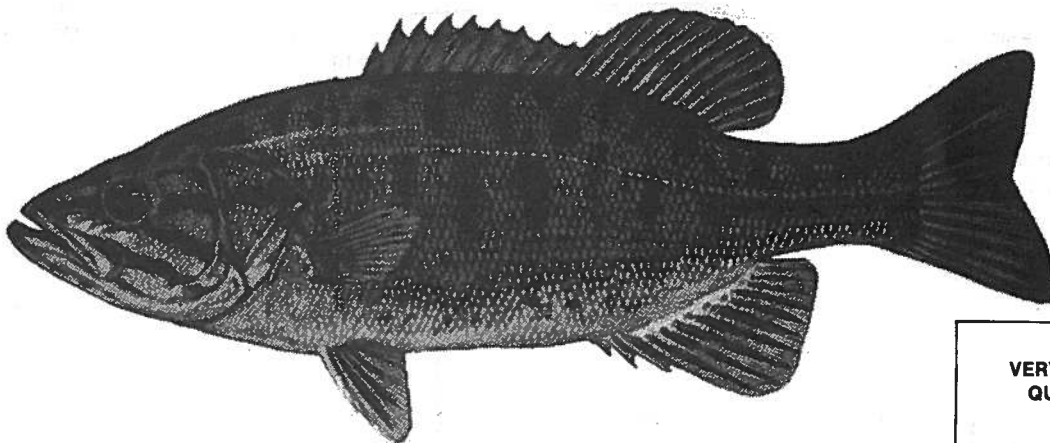
Our Large Mouth Bass are an extremely fast growing fish. They reproduce at 1 to 2 years of age and are full grown at 5 years. They are prized by anglers for their fighting ability and trophy sizes.

Be sure to stock your pond properly, adding enough forage fish for your bass. They should be stocked at a ratio of one bass to five to ten Blue or Red Gills.

If you are stocking just a Bass and Blue Gill combination, a ten to one ratio is recommended. If you are adding Shiners, Fathead Minnows, etc. a five to one ratio is recommended.

The growth rate of your bass is dependent entirely upon your forage fish. A 2 inch fingerling bass can grow to a 12 inch - 15 inch fish in one season with proper feed; on the other hand a 2 inch fish with no feed or forage fish will be 2 inches a year later.

Therefore, stocking the proper forage fish with bass is of utmost importance in a stocking program.

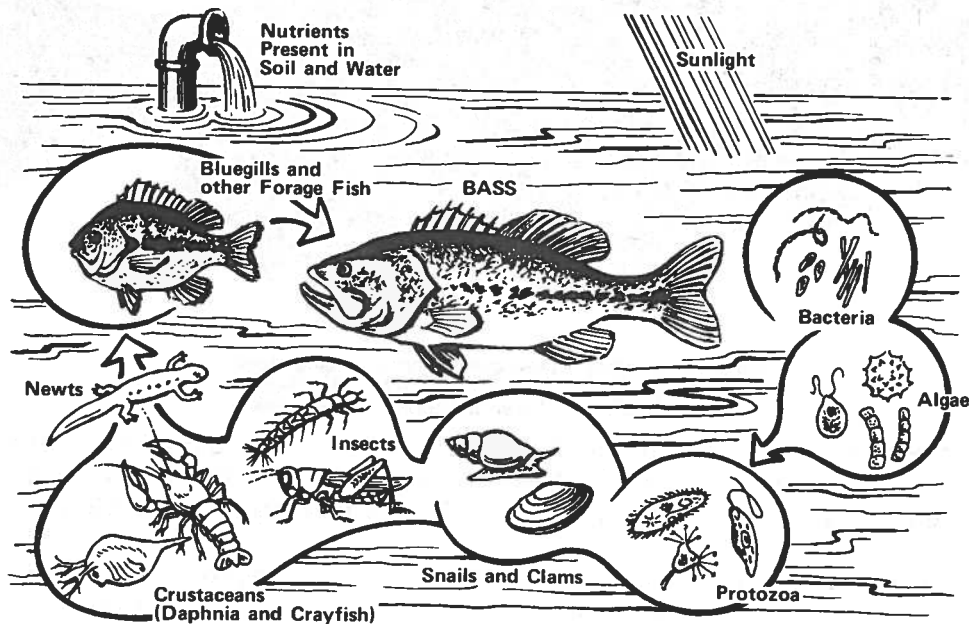

STOCKING INFORMATION

We specialize in the natural balancing of ponds. For a pond to be successful and to produce fish of sizable sport value you must imitate nature's way. We strongly recommend a stocking of many species of fish as most of the fish spawn at different times of the year and they spawn in sufficient quantities to provide food for themselves and the other fish in the ponds. Out of each spawn a certain amount will survive to grow into adult fish.

All the food fish, forage fish, and food animals should be stocked with your fish at the time of stocking. Blue gills, minnows, snails, clams, bullfrogs and daphnia are all part of the natural fish food chain.

Ponds and lakes should be planted with shallow water flowering plants and flowering water lilies. These plants not only add to the appearance of your pond, but also provide areas where small fish can hide from the larger fish and they also attract insects for feed. Fish will not live or grow on water alone. Be sure to stock food, fish and animals with them.

STOCKING TIME

Fish can be stocked year around, except in severe winter conditions. It is a common disbelief that fish are like garden plants or crops and can only be stocked in the spring. The best time to stock your fish is when your pond is ready or you are ready to stock.

If you have a new pond the water level should be at least 3 feet deep before stocking your fish.

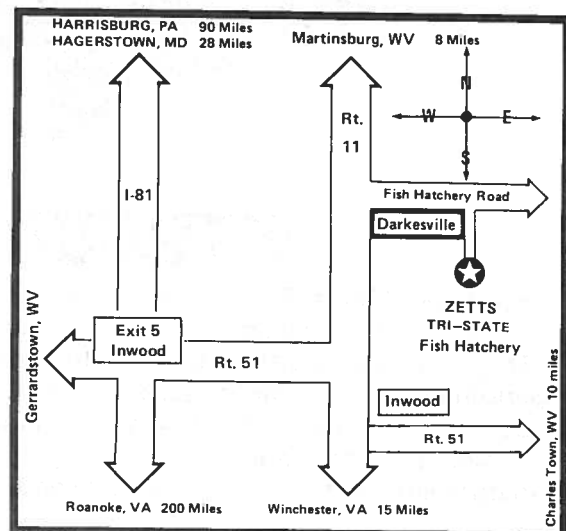
If your water is a little muddy or turbid from construction this will not bother your fish and the muddy water will soon clear up.

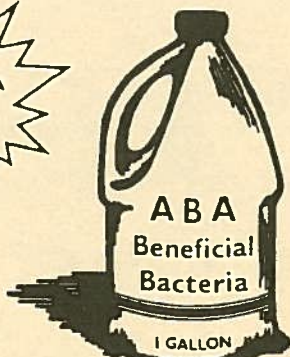

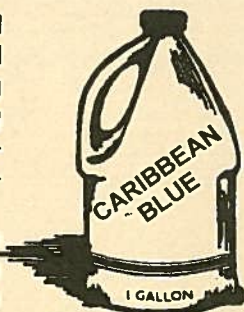
